MEMORIAL INSTALLATION APPLICATION

Policy on Memorials:

- 1.) **Monument Dealers and Lot Owners** are cautioned that all memorials (monuments and markers) are subject to approval by the caretaker **prior to** installation and delivery to the cemetery. Willow Glen Cemetery Association will not be responsible for any fees, loses or other monetary damages that you may incur if you purchase a memorial without prior approval in writing from the caretaker.
- 2.) A **Memorial Installation Application** must be delivered to the Caretaker for review and calculation of installation/foundation charges.
- 3.) A **Memorial Installation Application** must be approved and all fees paid **before delivery** of the memorial.
- 4.) Monument dealers will be notified by mail of the charges for the installation. Payment must be received by the cemetery prior to installation and/or construction of a foundation. Completion dates for installations and foundations are approximate and may be delayed due to weather or work conditions.
- 5.) **Memorialization restrictions apply throughout the cemetery.** One flush marker will generally be allowed on one grave. A marker or monument that is above the ground may be allowed on lots of two or more graves. Some lots of two or more graves are sold with restrictions that do not allow markers or monuments above the ground.
- 6.) All memorials are to be of natural stone or bronze. Artificially colored scenes and colored art are not allowed.
- 7.) All lettering, dates, epitaphs, verses, and art must be shown on the application.
- 8.) The cemetery reserves the right to remove any memorial that is constructed differently than as shown on the application.
- 9.) These rules are effective immediately and may be amended as the need arises. The cemetery reserves the right to put other rules in effect as the need may arise.

Lot Owner and Monument Dealer Agreement

We agree to comply with the memorial regulations of the Willow Glen Cemetery. We further agree that any monument delivered to the cemetery will have first been approved of by representatives of the cemetery and any installation/foundations fees paid in full and if not so then the cemetery may refuse to allow installation or erection of the memorial work or may remove the memorial. **Dated** / / .

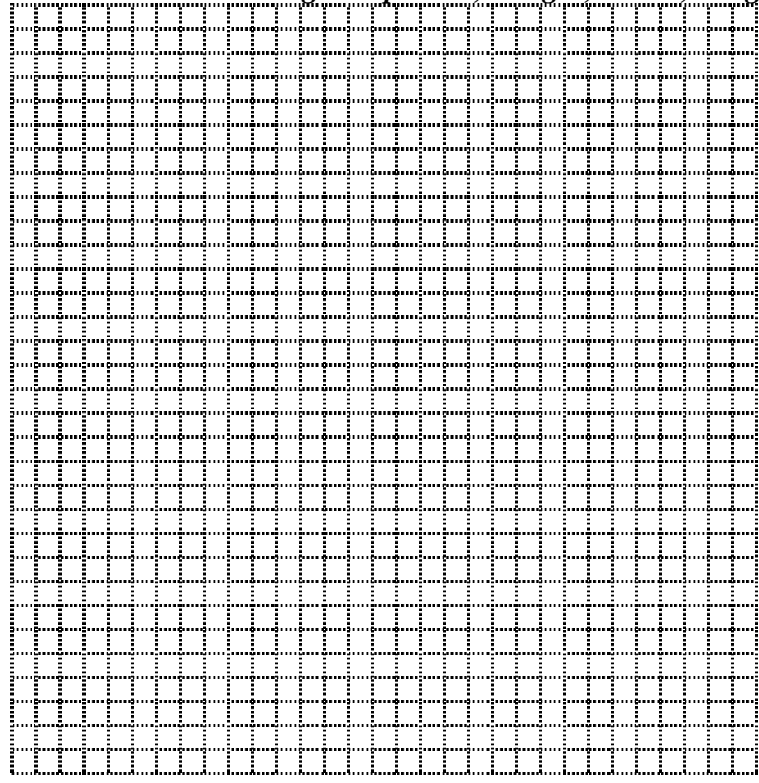
